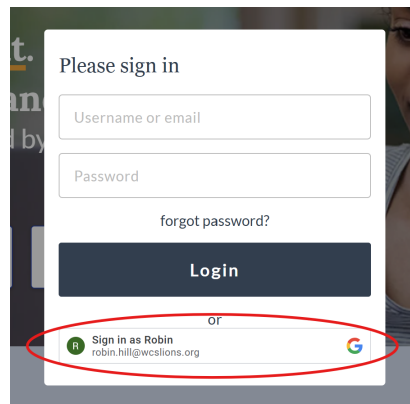


WCS Summer Math Assignment Instructions:

STEP 1: Click on the link at the bottom of this page to access your summer math assignment. Make sure you click on the correct class. For example, if you are taking Geometry for the 2026-27 school year, then you need to click on the GEOMETRY link at the bottom of this document.

STEP 2: Students will need to be logged into their WCS Google Account (school email only) when they log into Delta Math. See image below.



STEP 3: Once the student is logged in, they will have access to the summer math assignment.

When working on the assignment, the students will see a list of skills on the left side of the page. They can work them in order or click on different skills and work on them individually.

If the student has a question or is confused about the instructions, they can click on the SHOW EXAMPLE tab at the upper right corner of the page OR they can watch a lesson video. You can find the videos at the upper left corner of the question.

If the student needs a CALCULATOR, they have access to one on the lower left corner of the page. If they need a GRAPHING CALCULATOR, they just need to click on the drop down arrow next to the calculator to locate the one used for graphing.

YOU MUST TURN IN YOUR WORK! Delta Math enables you to upload your work into the assignment. While this is the preferred method, if you are unable to upload your work, **you are required to submit your work to your teacher on the first day of school.** Click [here](#) to access a printable blank work page or you may use lined paper.

PENALTY EXPLAINED: The summer math assignments are designed with a penalty for wrong answers. If the skill you are working on has a requirement of 3 questions, then you must correctly answer 3 questions. For every missed question, it will take your total back 1. For example, if you get the first 2 questions correct, your total score will be 2/3 after your second question and you will only need one more correct answer. However, if you miss your third question, your score will have a penalty of 1 point and your total score will become 1/3. Since the requirement is 3 correct answers (total score of 3/3), you will need to get two more correct answers to fulfill the skill requirement.
